- Experiencing possibly life-threatening symptoms or illness: come in immediately to be evaluated in the Emergency Department!
- If you do not feel that your symptoms are life-threatening, but you still need to be evaluated by a
 member of our emergency team, you can call 865-355-4940 prior to leaving for the hospital, and
 ask to be put on the call-ahead waiting list for the Emergency Department.

Non-life-threatening but requires immediate care:

· Sore throat

· Strep throat

· Urinary tract infection

· Vomiting and diarrhea

- Allergies
- Anergies
 Asthma
- Cough
- Ear pain
- Fever below 101° F
- Flu
- Minor burn
- Minor injury, e.g. sprained ankle
- Rash or skin irritation
- Simple laceration
- Sinus infection

immediate

- Abdominal pain
- Bleeding or sharp abdominal pains when pregnant
- Bleeding that will not stop
- Broken bones or major fracture
 Serious burn
- Chest pain
- Difficulty breathing
 Excruciating pain
- Extensive cut or laceration

ovenant

- Fainting or head injury
- Fever above 102° F

Life-threatening and requires immediate care:

- Loss of consciousness or
- disorientation

 Loss or change in vision
- Loss or change in vision
 Seizure
- Serious burn
- Severe allergic reactions
- Snake bite
 Spinal injury
- Stroke, numbriess and/or
- facial drooping
- Vomiting or coughing up blood
