Patients are encouraged to wear comfortable clothing..

After registration of ultrasound patients, the patient will be escorted to our outpatient waiting area. If lab work is required, this will be completed prior to the exam. A sonographer will explain the procedure prior to the exam and answer questions. Patients will need to be NPO (nothing by mouth) for all abdominal studies and renal artery exams. Patients will also need a full bladder for all renal/pelvic exams.

Our radiologists will read the exam and results will be sent to your ordering physician the same day. If your physician requests copies of your exam, a CD will be provided prior to your discharge.
