

# **WHAT IS PRIMARY CARE?**

Your primary care physician provides day-to-day healthcare, including:

- Patient education and counseling
- Health promotion and maintenance
- Disease prevention
- Diagnosis and treatment of acute and chronic illnesses
- Annual wellness physical and labs

Medical services are provided by supervising physician, David Vastine, MD, nurse practitioners, and other support staff.

## **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**

Care is provided at no cost to Sevier County government employees and their dependents with Sevier County government insurance.

Commonly prescribed medications are available through the Sevier County Wellness Clinic Dispensary at no cost.

## HOW DO I SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT?

To reduce wait times, appointments are recommended. If immediate care is needed, you may walk in with no appointment. The Sevier County Wellness Clinic is open:

Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday: 8am - 4:30pm

Wednesday and Friday: 8am - 12pm

# **DISPENSARY PROCEDURES**

- The dispensary is not a pharmacy and is operated according to regulations established by the State of TN Board of Medical Examiners.
- Established patients are required to meet with a clinic provider when receiving a medication for the first time or when a current medication changes.
- Call the clinic to request a prescription refill. You will be notified when the medication is ready for pick up.
