

Discharge Instructions for Carotid Surgery

Report to physician

- 1. Redness or swelling of incision
- 2. Chills or fever
- 3. Drainage or bleeding from incision
- 4. Excessive pain or tenderness at incision site

Wound Care

- 1. You may shower or take a tub bath after surgery.
- 2. You may remove the clear dressing (op-site) one week after surgery.
- 3. If after dressing is removed there is some drainage, cleanse incision three times daily with peroxide and cover with a light gauze dressing.
- 4. It is normal to experience numbness, incision pain, sore throat, hoarseness or difficulty swallowing. These symptoms usually improve within a few weeks after surgery.

Activity

- 1. Driving: No driving of a motor vehicle for at least two weeks post-operatively. The Dr. will specify if you are to have any further driving restrictions.
- 2. Your activity should consist of short walks and your normal routine to tolerance. Please consult your Dr, regarding participation in any special activities.
- 3. No lifting over 10 pounds for at least 8 weeks, unless otherwise directed.

Post-operative Visit

Please contact office when discharged from hospital to make a suture removal appointment for 3-4 weeks after surgery.
