- ◆ Tuition includes diapers, wipes, breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack
- ◆ 5% sibling discount is given on the lowest tuition

Other fees:

- ◆ An annual \$135.00 registration fee per child will be assessed every September 1st and/or when you turn in your initial enrollment forms.
- ◆ There is a \$30 fee for all returned checks and automatic withdrawals.
- ◆ A \$30 late fee is charged to any account paid after the 10th of the month.
An additional \$10 late fee is charged to any account paid after the 20th of the month.
An additional \$10 late fee is charged to any account paid after the 25th of the month.
- Parents are required to pick up **New Enrollment Paperwork** at least 2 weeks prior to enrollment – along with the **Nanny's Parent Handbook**. At that time, you are required to pay the \$135.00 registration fee per child to hold the space(s) until the scheduled enrollment date.

Please note the following information:

- ◆ Nanny's does not assign numbers to people on the waiting list. Applications are kept in order of application date. Application date is based on the date the application fee of \$50 is received.
- ◆ Siblings of children currently enrolled at Nanny's will receive priority from the wait list when a spot becomes available. The siblings must be enrolled at the same time to receive this priority.
- ◆ If your child is not yet born when you get on the waiting list, it is the sole responsibility of the parents to contact Nanny's when the child is born. Spaces will not be offered to anyone if confirmation of birth has not been given.
- ◆ If your contact information changes at any time, please call Nanny's to update your information.
- ◆ When a space becomes available, the next person on the list will be contacted regardless of schedule available or schedule requested. You will be given two business days to respond with acceptance or declination.
- ◆ All immunizations required by the Knox County Health Department must be current upon the first day of enrollment and remain up to date for continued enrollment – no exceptions allowed.
- ◆ Nanny's is a group care environment. While we try to individualize our program as much as possible – we must comply with the regulations set forth by the State of Tennessee. At the age of 13 (thirteen) months, children will begin following a classroom schedule. Nanny's will begin potty-training after their second birthday so they are trained by their third birthday (a Nanny's requirement).
